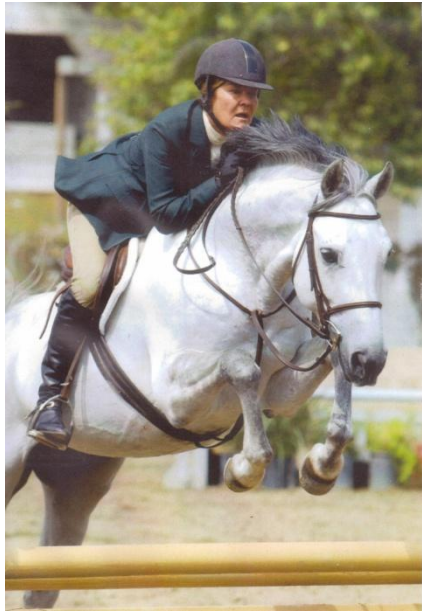


NEWS ARTICLE – LESLIE MCNIFF MOVES TO MALIBU



Hunter/jumper trainer Leslie McNiff has moved her show jumping business, Whiskey Hill Farms, to GT Malibu Sporthorses, Mulholland Drive, Malibu.

Leslie is an all-round horsewoman who started riding at the age of three in Woodside, California. Leslie has been riding the A circuit for 40 years and has been one of the top ten show jumping riders for the past 25 years, riding at Spruce Meadows, Canada; The Goodyear series in Arizona; Indio (Hits Series); and all the young Jumper competitions at The Oaks, Del Mar and Griffith Park, winning numerous medals and championships.

She trained with Olympian George Morris: current Chef d'Equipe of the US Olympic team, as well as Patricia Blakiston: 2009 Horsewoman of the Year, top Grand Prix rider Bert Mutch and Champ & Linda Hough.

McNiff trains students from beginner to advanced: "Each student is different, but I find repetition is the key to success. I strongly believe in patience and consistency while the student has fun learning." Lessons can be group or individually taught.

Leslie loves teaching young riders: "Horsemanship is such an important skill for young people, it teaches them focus, discipline and goal setting."

Leslie also trains horses from pre-green to Intermediate jumpers, where her philosophy is "to think like a horse to train one". She offers full service care with her carefully structured training schedule for horses.
